Caitie is in the process of scheduling with a surgical oncologist for a NON-cancerous mass they have found in her abdomen.

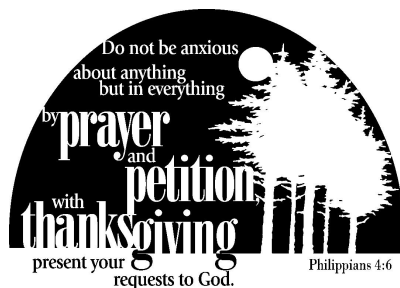
Nancy P.'s coworker's sister, Rachel, is in need of a heart transplant.
